She doesn't have to wear glasses, except to read. This is the first time she hasn't needed glasses since she was 9 years old.

We were richly blessed last week to have 2 Chilean pastors visit us in our home, Bro. Luis, and Bro. Jaime. They are visiting Bro. Harold Laird, and he & Peggy brought them down. I baptized Bro. Luis, more than 20 years ago, in Santiago, Chile. They have both been pastoring for a number of years now. So the Lord's work continues, and increases.

Alice June's younger sister, "Bunty" (Sara Vivian) passed away January 21 in Pine Bluff, Arkansas after a brief hospitalization. Sharon and her girls made the quick trip to Arkansas with us for the funeral. Today would have been her birthday. This is the last of June's family other than some nephews & a few cousins. Please remember her husband and sons in your prayers, as well as Alice June.

The Lord gave me an unusual experience 3 weeks ago. That week at the VA here in Hattiesburg I had blood drawn as usual for a test. Sometime pretty soon after, the nurse dropped the vial and lost the blood. She called the house and told June I would have to come back. Sharon had taken me, and June called us on the cell phone. However, since my wife had an appointment in Hattiesburg the next morning, I just waited to go back until then. This happened Wednesday, and I asked the church that night to be praying, as I wanted to talk to the technician about her soul some more. Over the years when I have given blood, I always ask the attendant if they knew Who the greatest blood Donor in the world was? Usually the attendant will ask me to repeat what I said. Thursday morning I asked the lab tech if she knew WHY she had spilled the blood, and her reply was negative. I told her so I could talk to her some more about her being saved. During the time I spoke with her, she called on the Lord...aloud. Praise the Lord!! I gave her a gospel of John, which she was very happy to receive. I want to continue to keep in touch by phone.

Continue to pray with us for Michael. He is still working and feels pretty good following the removal of some lymph glands. The oncologist has not begun treatment yet, wanting to wait for him to have another CAT scan.

We had an accidental death here in the community last week. My cousin's son was talking on his cell phone as he drove, and ran into a tree. At 5:30 he was planting potatoes in the garden, and at 6:30 he was dead. He had only been married two months.

Ebenezer has a youth revival beginning tonight through Wednesday night. We are praying for unusual blessings.
