Beloved Friends and Family,

Though it seems hardly possible, one fourth of 2008 has already passed! How quickly the days and even years pass...as James says, "Even as a vapor" (chapter 4: 14). On February 28<sup>th</sup> Eldwyn and I passed our 61<sup>st</sup> wedding anniversary, and on March 14, Eldwyn had his 84<sup>th</sup> birthday. Either fact seems incredible!

Many, if not most of you, like I, have been going to church all your lives, so you probably know a great number of the old hymns without having to look at the words in the hymnal. If my mind should happen to wander while we are singing, however, occasionally I have looked at our church bulletin, and wondered if the hymn I'm seeing there is the one we *JUST* sang, or the one we are to sing *NEXT*! So I have been trying to make a concerted effort to *LISTEN* to the words I am singing. I have had a special hymn on my heart for sometime now, which I would like to share with you:
