Loper and Bro. Allen both worked. They got there in time for the morning service and three of them preached that morning. They had lunch and then headed back toward the capital and got to Villarrica for the evening services and three of them preached again that night. After services they headed on back to Asuncion(the three men had to be at work on Mon.) and got home about 1AM!! So they were almost 24 hrs. without stopping. He said the services were all such a blessing and the fellowship in the car on the trip was great.
