Update from Cindy

Dear Brethren,

I am taking a few minutes to send an update from here in Mozambique. We are thankful to say we have had several professions of faith in the last few weeks and have some ready for baptism. Dan made a quick trip up north a couple weeks ago to set up the date for the ordination of a brother up there. This week he came down with malaria that he contracted while up there. He is very weak. We took him to see the dr. on Wednesday and he gave him drip and then sent him home with medicine. He is very weak and achey, but thankfully, has been able to hold food on his stomach and his chills have subsided now. Malaria is very hard on your body and it will likely take some time for him to be recovered in strength. Please pray for him. The date for the ordination above mention was the first weekend in June, IF he has the strength to make the trip.

We had a baptism planned for tomorrow, which had to be postponed until he is better. Peter and Holly are visiting us for a couple months and he has been a real help to us here. He will be preaching on Sunday...he hasn't forgotten much Portuguese, even after an absence of 5 yrs.

We also have plans to return to the US for furlough in September. Our landlord gave us notice that they need our house by the end of August. As we were already praying about the Lord's timing for our trip home, this just gave us the date. We have a prospect of a piece of property for our church in Trevo, but it seems to be on hold for the present. Please pray that we can find land before we leave.

I know Dan will write a much better letter than this when he is able to send his newsletter out, but I felt that there are many issues that need prayer at this time. Thank you all for your faithful prayer support!!
