We found out that our process had been approved several weeks ago and had gotten misplaced and if Dan had not gone in and spoken with that lady we would not have been able to get our documents in time. Then when he finally got the authorization tetter he headed-to immigrations and there they told him he needed several other documents...which were not listed on the board. He asked permission to speak to somebody with authority and thankfully the director signed his approval of our documents and he was able to submit them in time. The daily fine for late documents is about \$200 per day. We are so thankful we got them all in on time We reioice as well that we got our church authorization! ' "J"11-1-. ao
