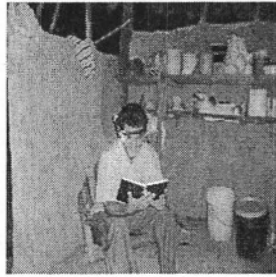

We want to thank you for your offerings and above all your prayers for our family, and the ministry the Lord has given us in the Interior of Panama. We continue Walking with God (name of radio program), serving Him in different areas.

The Radio Programs continues to be a blessing to thousands. It is encouraging to receive calls from people asking for Christian literature, and others who receive Christ as their Lord and personal Savior. It has been interesting to hear the testimonies of couples who have reconciled after hearing the programs on marriage. My program is aired each day from 1pm. to 2 pm.

We work hard in the small **print shop** in our house, producing the correspondence studies that we offer free of charge to people through the radio program and personally. I am grateful to the congregation that meets in our house for their valuable help in this ministry. It is wonderful to see the effect of the Bible in people's lives. We have seen lives changed.

A young man who cannot walk was won to the Lord in one of my discipleship visits. It was a blessing when he said, "Perhaps I can't walk physically, but I want to start walking with God." Now he is a member of the mission in Santiago.

People saved, new members and congregations growing in faith encourage me to keep on proclaiming the message of the Lord in other towns. Beloved, I want to ask you to pray especially for two missions, Santiago and Cañazas, which will be organized as **Independent Baptist Churches** and will ordain their respective pastors in February of 2007.

The brethren of **the Indian areas** have now established two stable congregations, Cerro Puerco and Palma Gira. Bro. Francisco Mariano has been a big help in discipleship and in preaching the Word among the Guaymi Indians. These brethren have their services in their own language.

The Mission in Cañazas continues to support the small congregation in **San Juan de Dios**. Next month they will build a small building in which to have services.

We thank the Lord that this year we have been able to reach **new towns** with the Gospel message by passing out thousands of tracts, offering Bible studies, and discipling new believers, even in the areas that are hard to get to.

I want to thank the Lord for **my wife and daughters** who are a special treasure to me and a great help in the ministry. They enjoy serving the Lord in the print shop, the radio program, and working in the correspondence school. My wife especially helps me with the correspondence school and dealing with all the people who visit our house from the different communities.

Finally I would like to thank you one more time for your offerings and prayers which make it possible for us to deliver the Good News, the message of salvation, to people in different places in the Interior of Panama.
